

# **BRIARCLIFF WOODS BEACH CLUB**

## **CODE OF CONDUCT**

The following Pool Rules shall apply to all members of the Briarcliff Woods Beach Club, hereafter referred to as BWBC, and to their guests and shall be strictly enforced:

### **1. HEALTH AND SAFETY**

Children three (3) years of age and under that enter the main pool shall wear a swim diaper and plastic pants. [Should a child have a fecal incident in the main pool while not wearing the required swim diaper and plastic pants, a \$200.00 fee shall be assessed to the member by BWBC so as to meet the contractual obligations entered into with Sweetwater Swim Management Company for the proper cleaning of the pool. The pool shall remain closed for 24 hours after such an incident, in accordance with DeKalb County Health Code.];

Children four (4) years of age and under shall be accompanied by an adult when using the bathroom facilities;

No water pistols or water guns of any kind are allowed in the pools of BWBC

Slapping floatable “noodles” on surface of the water is prohibited;

Tennis balls are prohibited in the main pool and in the baby pool;

The lost and found container shall be cleaned out every first and third week and any item not claimed shall be disposed of; and

Members and their guests are expected to clean up after themselves and their children. Trash receptacles are located around the pool and in bathroom facilities;

No smoking is permitted inside the fence of the pool;

No glass containers are permitted inside the fence of the pool;

### **2. DIVING BOARD**

One person at a time on the diving board—all members and their guests shall wait on the concrete pool deck for their turn; and

No person shall use the diving board until the previous person using the diving board has reached the ladder on the side of the pool;

### **3. BABY POOL**

Only children six (6) and under shall be allowed in the baby pool, and such children shall be supervised by a parent or guardian; and

All children who are not potty trained must wear a swim diaper and plastic pants;

### **4. ADULT SWIM**

During adult swim, at no time will any person under the age of 18 be allowed in the pool or on the stairs, ladders, or diving boards, with the exception of children four (4) years of age or under when they are accompanied by a parent or guardian;

### **5. FOUL LANGUAGE**

As BWBC is a family-oriented recreation facility, foul or abusive language is prohibited;

### **6. IMPROPER BEHAVIOR**

Any behavior that puts a member or their guest at risk of injury, including but not limited to fighting, wrestling, running, pushing, shoving, and any other behavior that is deemed by lifeguards, board-appointed monitors, or board members to be reckless, irresponsible, or dangerous, is prohibited;

## **7. DISRESPECTFUL BEHAVIOR**

Any behavior deemed to be disrespectful, abusive, or harassing toward lifeguards or any other member of BWBC or their guest is prohibited;

## **8. UNACCOMPANIED MINOR CHILD**

Unaccompanied minor children (ages 10 –15) are required to provide emergency telephone numbers in the event that notification of a parent or guardian is necessary;

## **9. TRESPASSING**

Trespassing by any member or their guest on BWBC property after regular pool hours shall result in the suspension of that member's pool privileges for up to one (1) year or as set forth by the BWBC Board of Directors; and

## **10. SUSPENSION**

Briarcliff Woods Beach Club continues to ensure that all members and their guests can enjoy a family-oriented environment for fun and relaxation. As such, all the above rules of conduct shall be strictly enforced by lifeguards, board-appointed monitors, and board members. Violation of these rules shall result in the following consequences:

All offenses shall be documented. Consistent violations of any rule by any member or their guest shall result in the removal of that member or their guest from the pool for one (1) day; Prior to removing a minor member or their minor guest from the premises, documented attempt to contact the parent, guardian, or emergency contact person of such minor member or guest shall be made by the lifeguards, board-appointed monitors, or board members and the parent, guardian, or emergency contact person of such minor member or guest shall be expected to pick up such minor immediately upon such contact;

If any member is suspended from the pool three (3) times in a calendar year, that member shall be suspended from ALL club privileges for a period of one (1) month;

The fourth (4<sup>th</sup>) suspension of any member in any calendar year shall result in suspension of ALL club privileges for that member for the remainder of that calendar year; and

If destruction of property is involved with any incident that leads to the suspension of a member or their guest, such member shall be suspended until the next quorum of the Board of Directors, which shall at such time decide upon any further suspension or action.
